

2021 IMPACT REPORT



Completed **5 new single-family homes** for the Central Ohio Community Land Trust. Started construction on **Town Square Station**, a 10-unit apartment building at Town Street and Hawkes Avenue.

Celebrated **61 graduates over 11 cohorts** of our Financial Life-skills Program, which brings the total number to **261 graduates** since 2018. Hosted **11 guest speakers** from non-profits & banks.



Hosted the **third annual** Franklinton Job Fair with an in-person pop-up event with **Ohio Means Jobs**, and a virtual event with **over 25 partners** in workforce development, employment, and educational services.

Franklinton.org received over **36,000 page views**. Hilltopusa.org received over **15,000 page views**. Assisted more than **125 inquiries** on the community resource guides. Published **eleven issues** & distributed over **1,900 copies** of the Franklinton Newsletter.





The newly created **Franklinton Special Improvement District** joined the Franklinton Board of Trade and Community Crime Patrol as the third tenant sharing space with FDA in our Broad Street offices.

Canvassed over 580 households with Celebrate One, The Legal Aid Society of Columbus, The Refuge, and Columbus Public Health to distribute info about predatory buyers, Franklinton National Night Out, Franklinton.org, and other community resources.
