Announcement: Starling Yard



Franklinton Development Association is proud to partner as codeveloper with Woda Cooper Companies, Inc. to renovate the old Starling Middle School into affordable housing. The school was originally built in 1908 as West High School and will be turned into 45 apartments with 19 one-bedroom, 24 two-bedroom, and 2 three-bedroom units. There will be a total of 97 units on-site with the construction of two additional three story buildings to be added to the site. Construction is anticipated to begin by the end of the year.



Announcement: Nationwide 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline

The Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) is pleased to announce that Ohioans experiencing suicidal crisis, mental health or addiction-related distress are able to call 988, an easy-to-remember three-digit number to access free, 24/7, confidential support for themselves or loved ones. The nationwide 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline went live in mid-July. A trained crisis counselor will answer the phone, listen to the caller, provide support, and connect them to additional resources if needed. The Lifeline provides live crisis center phone services in English and Spanish and uses Language Line Solutions to provide translation services in over 250 additional languages for people who call 988. The 988 dialing code will also be available nationwide for text or chat (English only).

Is this a fire or police emergency or imminent danger to life? CALL 911.

Do I need help related to thoughts of suicide, mental health or addiction crisis? CALL 988.
