FEC Counselors are here to listen to your financial goals and help you achieve them, all completely free. To schedule your FEC session:

- 1. Create an account in Wayfynder and submit the intake form with "FEC session" or "financial counseling" to request your first session.
- 2. FEC Counselor will contact you to schedule your session and provide more information about the program.
- 3. Attend your first FEC session to establish your financial goals and build a plan
- 4. Schedule your follow-up session with the FEC counselor
