The fair will feature resources on affordable, accessible, and high-quality housing and services from more than 40 local housing organizations, government agencies and social service organizations. Admission is free. There is no ticket required.

During the resource fair, the **Franklin County Board of Revision (BOR) will offer a clinic for the Homeowner Assistant Program**. This clinic is available to low-to-moderate income homeowners to file a complaint against the valuation of their owner-occupied home with the County Board of Revision (BOR). The program provides complaint-filing clinic and referrals for possible further presentation for homeowners in Franklin County.

- Do not do city taxes.


